

NORTHWESTERN SHOWMEN'S CLUB SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Northwestern Showmen's Club is committed to educating the youth of this industry as well as those who are achieving goals later in life. All qualifying applicants will be equally considered.

Qualifying applicants will be any of the following:

- 1 High School senior with a cumulative GPA of 2.50 or higher applying to an accredited two or four year program at a University, Community or an accredited Technical or Trade School.
- 2 College student who has a cumulative GPA of 2.50 or higher and returning to school. (This includes a Masters program, although consideration will first be given to those pursuing their first undergraduate degree)
- 3 Individual who has chosen to return to school but has not recently graduated or attended college, but can provide adequate transcripts to demonstrate their academic performance while in school.

Applicant will also:

- 1 Be applying for or attending a full time program (in general 12 credits each quarter except summer quarter) or on a program schedule that the committee deems acceptable under special circumstances.
- 2 Be a member in good standing of Northwestern Showmen's Club for 1 year prior or related to the same. If not already a member, recipients will be required to join the NWSC at the time of the award, or on their 18th birthday.
- 3 Entirely and correctly complete the application and submit it along with their most recent official transcripts by the second Monday in December each year.
- 4 Submit two letters of recommendation from current teachers/faculty members, counselors, or employers regarding their scholastic aptitude and/or other qualifications.
- 5 If applicant is awarded the scholarship but is unable to use the gift by the end of the school year awarded, the applicant can reapply the following year.
- 6 All refunds will be directly paid to the Northwestern Showmen's Club scholarship account.

This is a competitive scholarship. Scholarships are based on superior academic skills, with consideration given to school performance and recommendations, as well as leadership ability. Consideration will also be given to extracurricular activities and involvement in the industry. Scholarships are awarded on the basis of the student's own merit, academic accomplishment, and commitment. Financial need and family situations are not factors. At the discretion of the NWSC, interviews with applicants may be required. Decisions of the NWSC are final.
